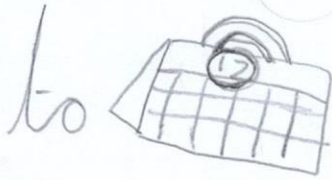

If a cat blinks slowly at you, it means they love you!

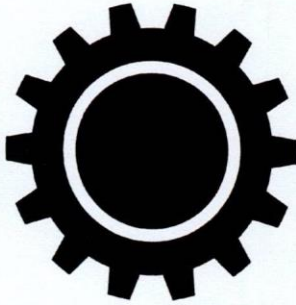
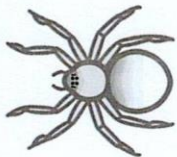

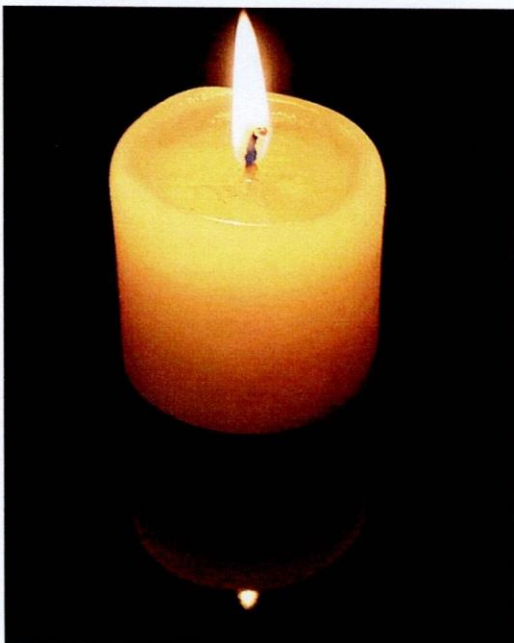
# What are we doing in Worship?

In the Caribbean country of Bermuda they traditionally fly hexagonal kites on *Good Friday*.

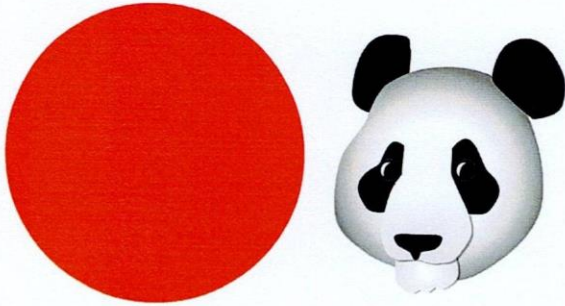
Flying kites reminds us of Jesus rising to heaven in the Easter story.



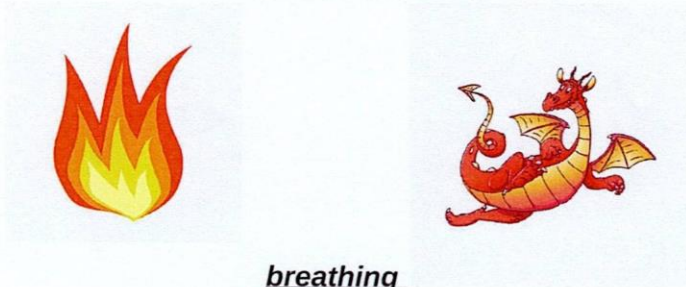
In some areas of Scandinavia children dress up a bit like halloween and ask for sweets on the streets.
