Please note: Unlike in previous years where children booked into tea club could access the extra-curricular clubs they won't be able to do this, this year. All children wanting to attend Blue Coat University must be registered to the club via Parent Pay. If you require your child to stay at tea club after the club has finished, you will need to inform the school office.



The clubs will have limited places, which must be booked and paid for via Parent Pay. Places will be on a first come first served basis **via Parent Pay which will go live Tuesday 21st October at 12pm**. Once the places have gone, you will be unable to access the club on Parent Pay.

If you wish to add any special comments, we request that they are also added to the notes section. If your child is in Year 5 or 6 and you are happy for your child to walk home from the club please also add this to the notes field even if you have completed a consent to walk home form.
